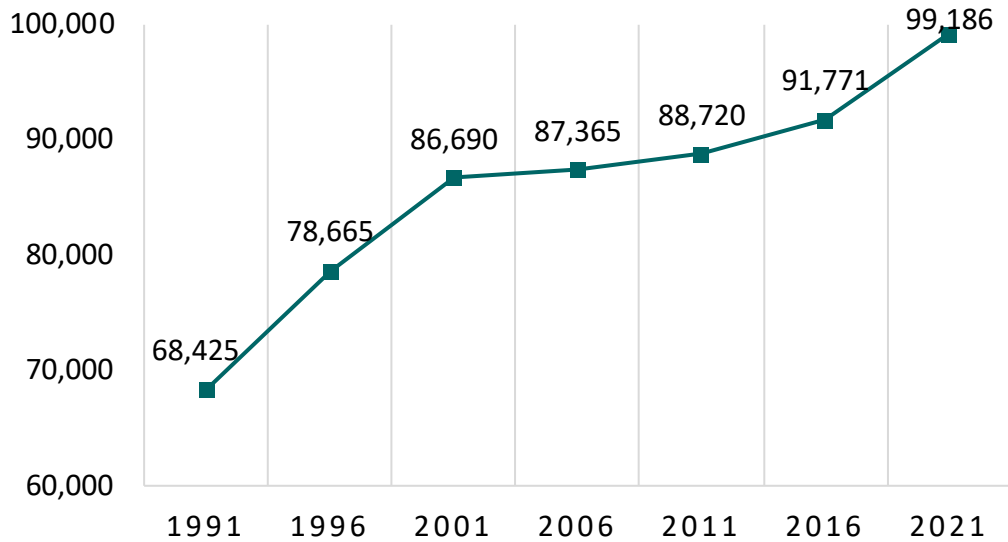

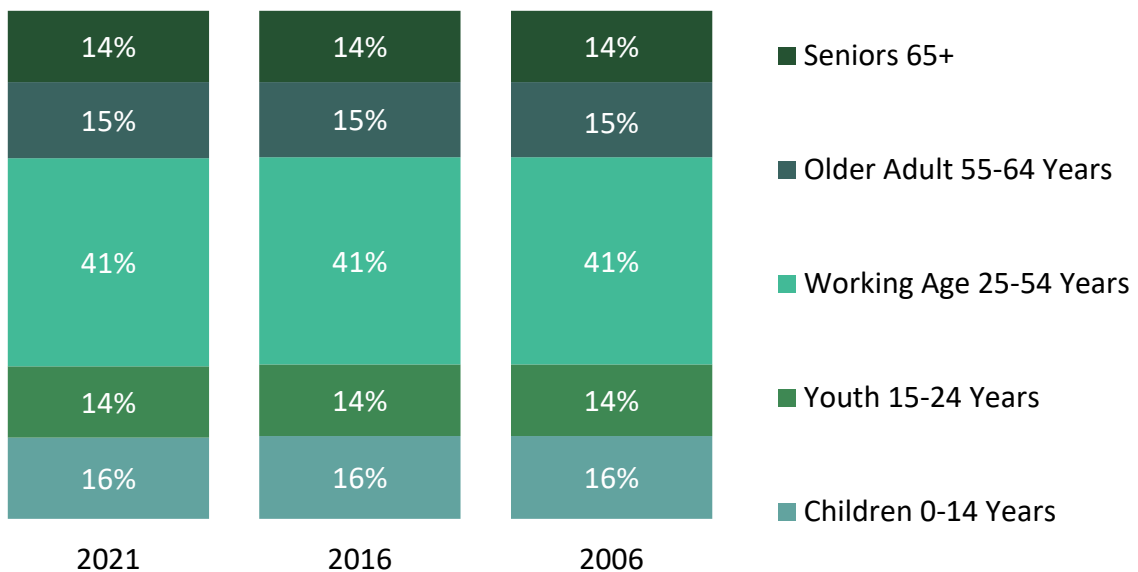

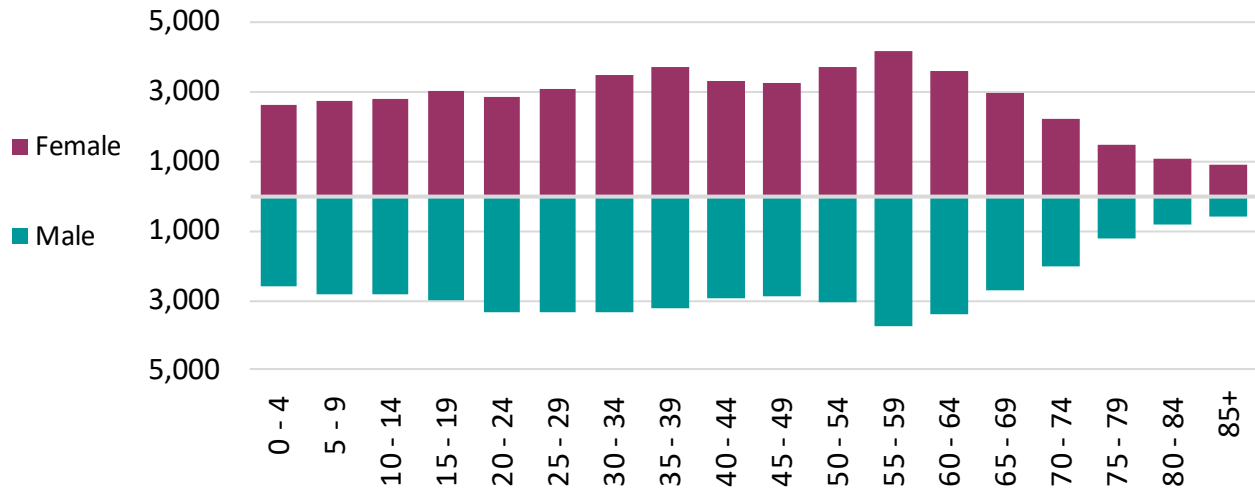


Population by Sex and Age Group

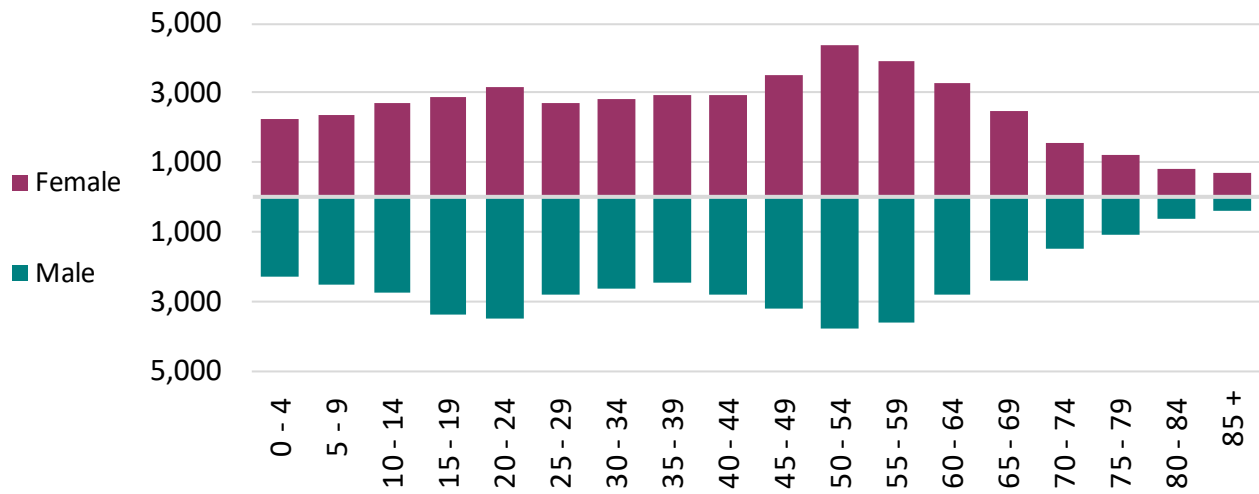

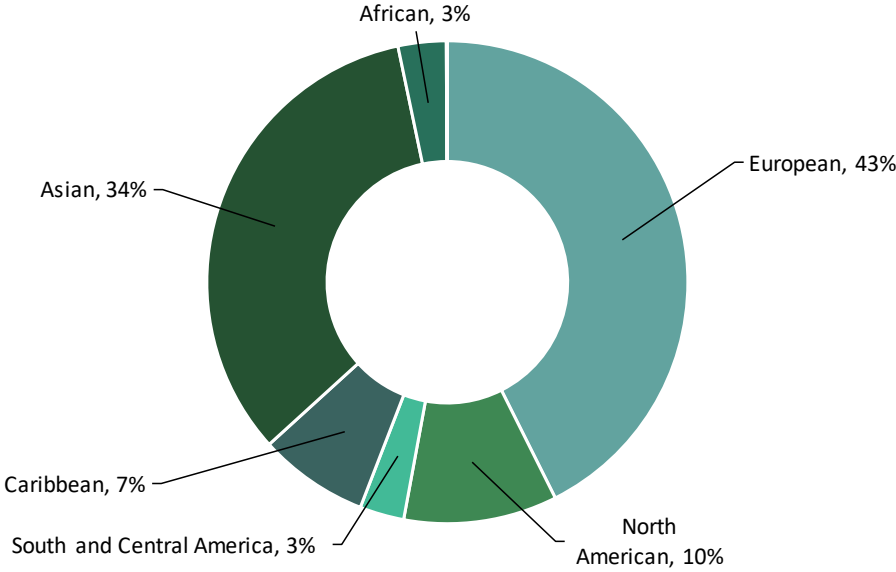

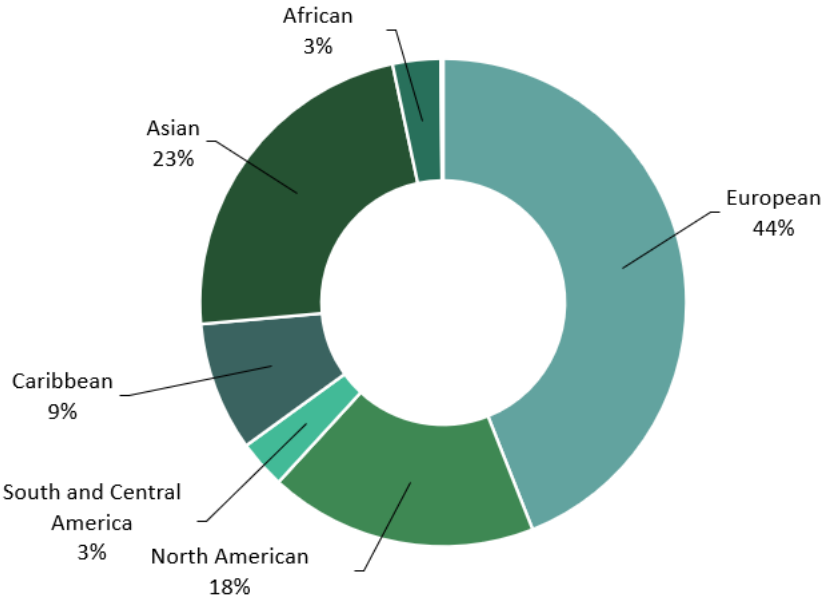

2016 Ethnic Origins

Ethnic Origin refers to the ethnic or cultural origins of the person’s ancestors. An ancestor is usually more distant than a grandparent. Respondents may select up to six ethnic origins.

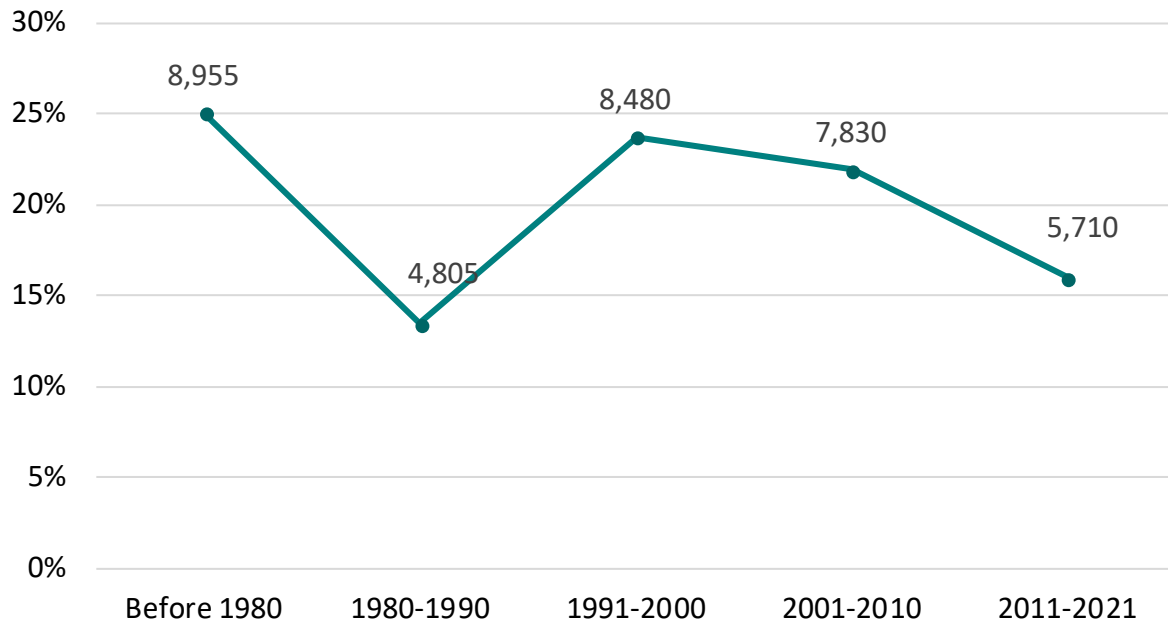
A person may have a single ethnic origin or may have multiple ethnicities based on a respondent’s perception of their ethnic ancestry.

Immigrants By Period of Immigration



Non-Immigrant refers to a person who is a **Canadian** citizen by birth.

Immigrant refers to a person who is, or who has ever been, a landed immigrant or a permanent resident. Such person has been granted the right to live in Canada permanently by immigration authorities. Immigrants who have obtained Canadian citizenship by naturalization are included in this category.

Non-Permanent Resident refers to a person from another country who has a work or study permit or who is a refugee claimant, and their family members sharing the same permit and living in Canada with them.

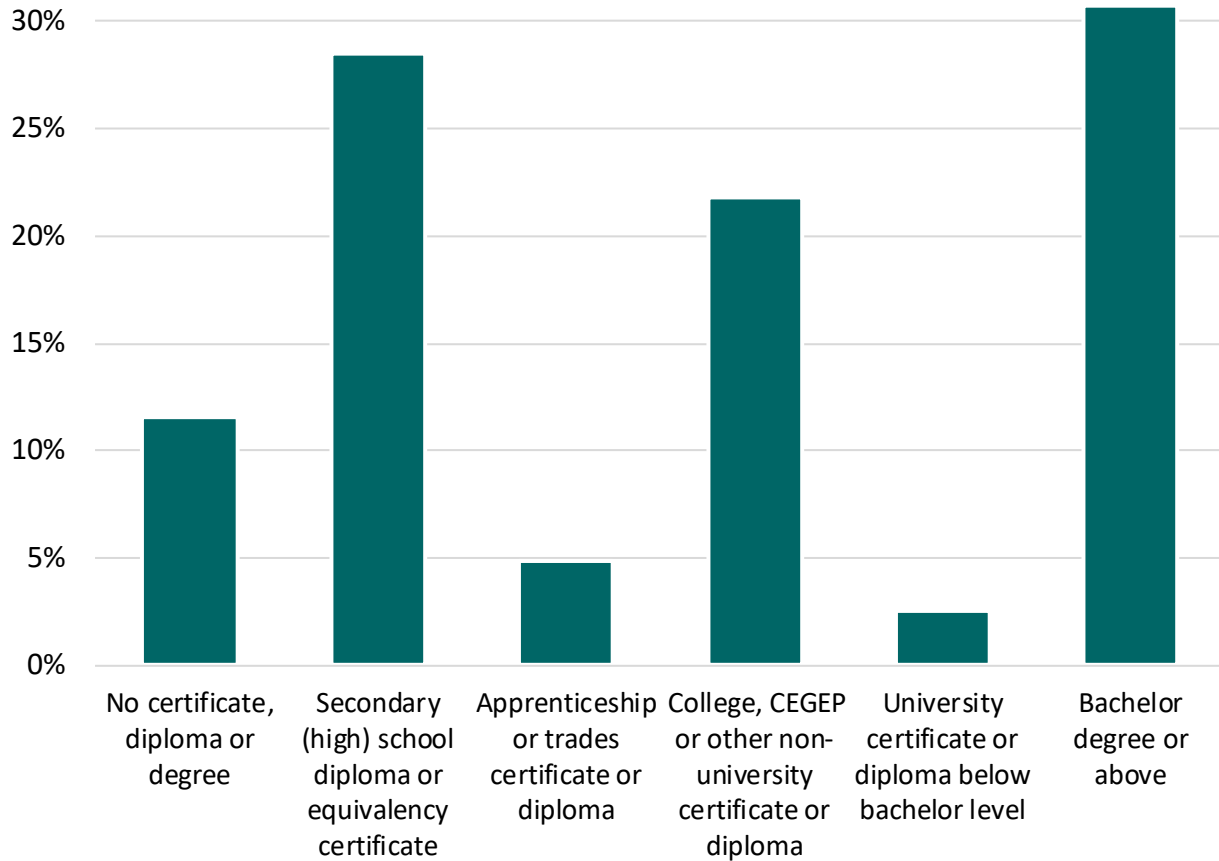

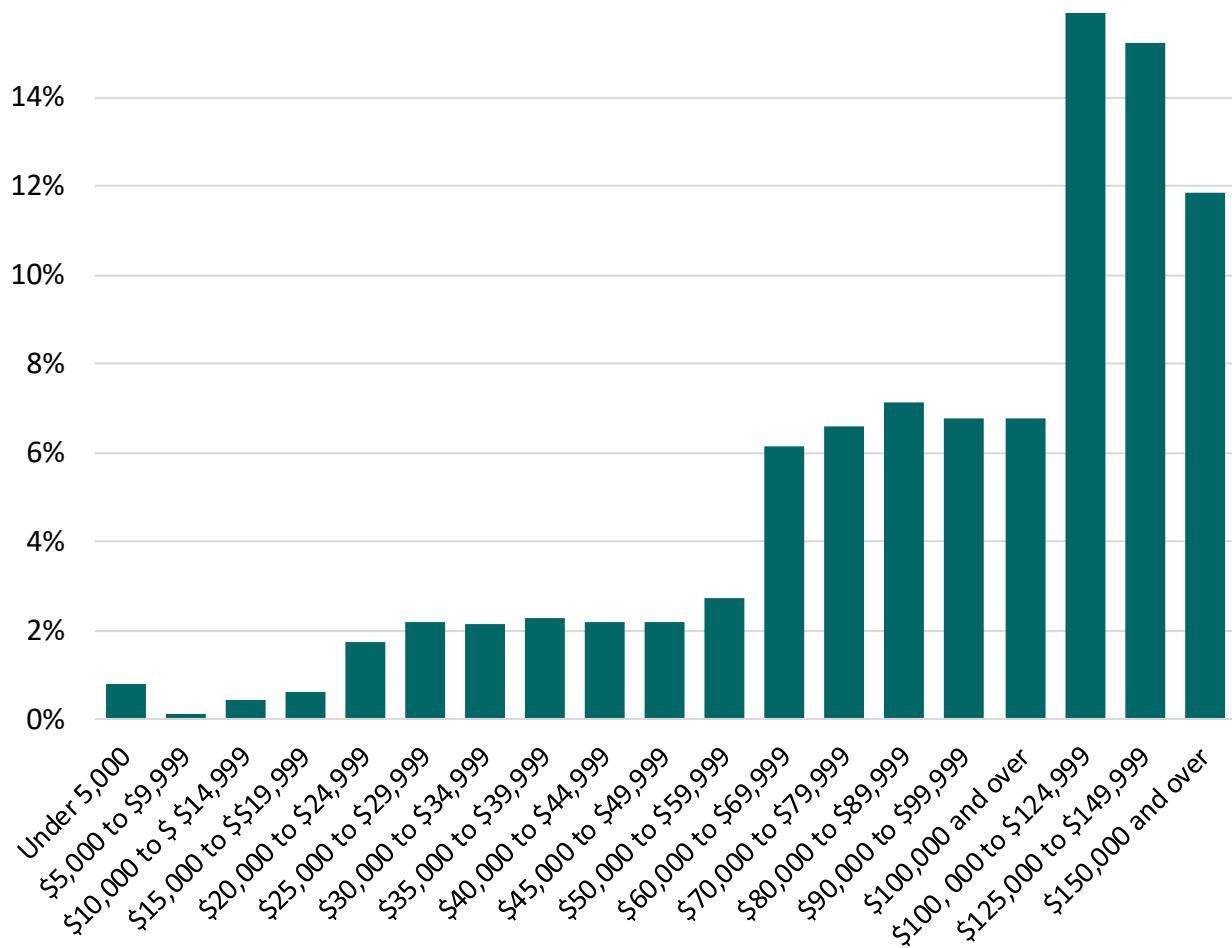

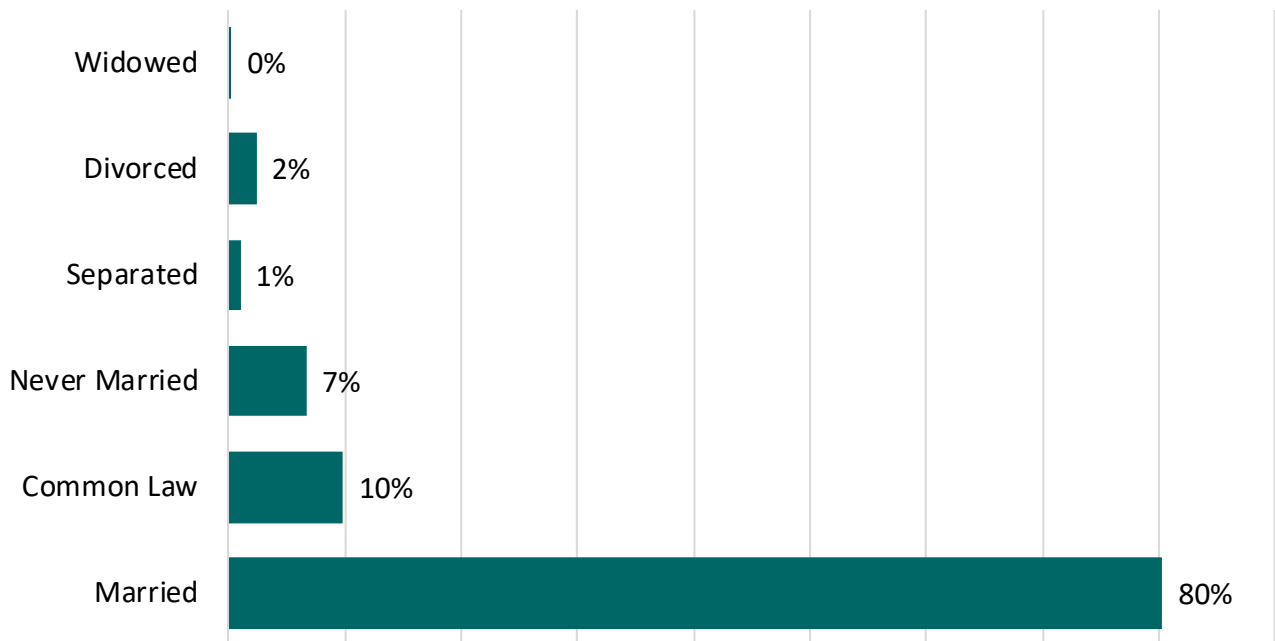
Distribution of Median Household Income



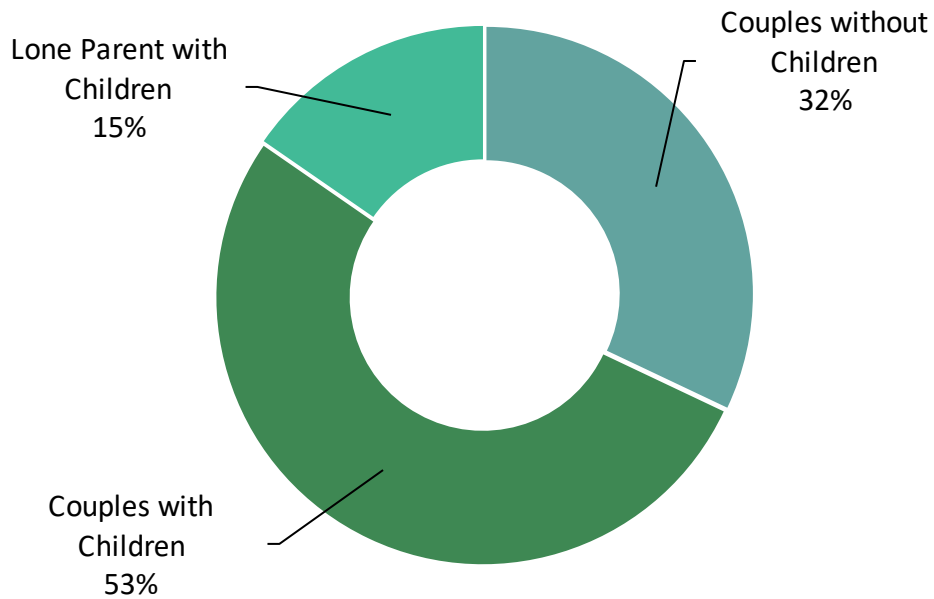
Median Household Income refers to the income level earned by a household where half of all households earn more and half earn less.

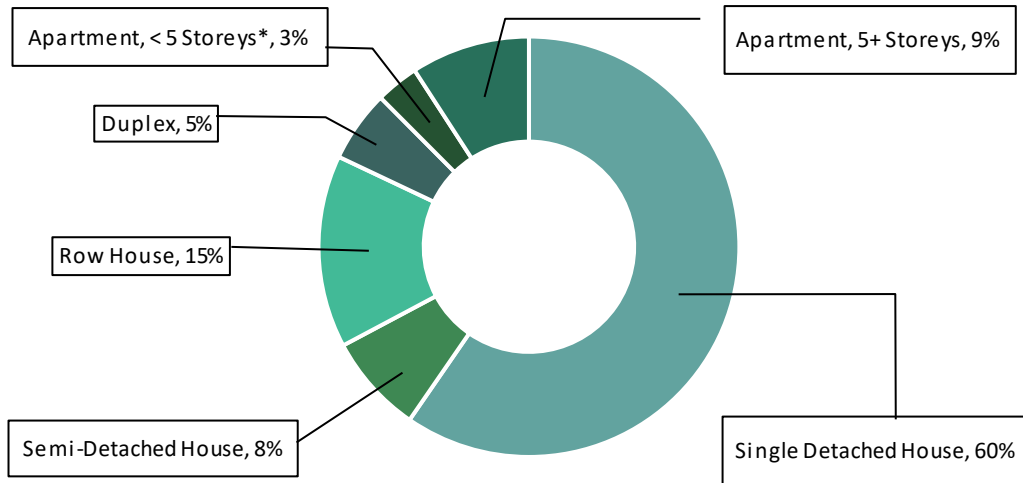

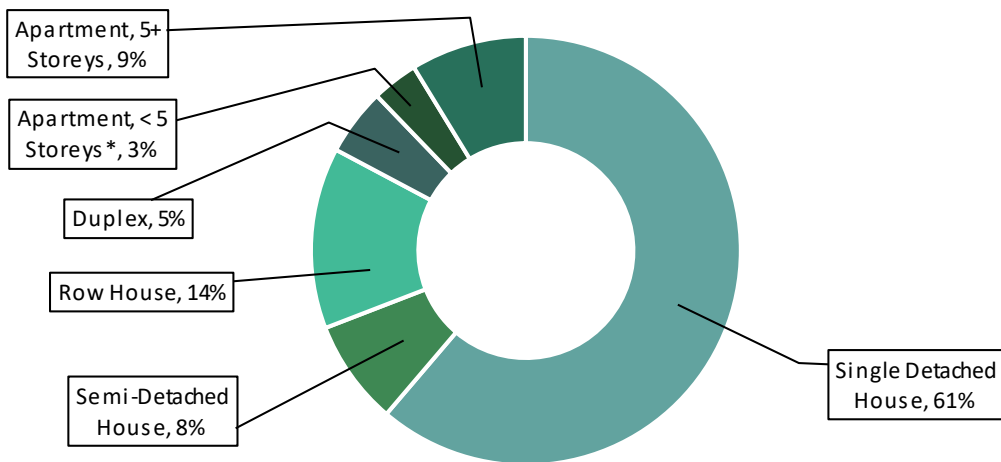

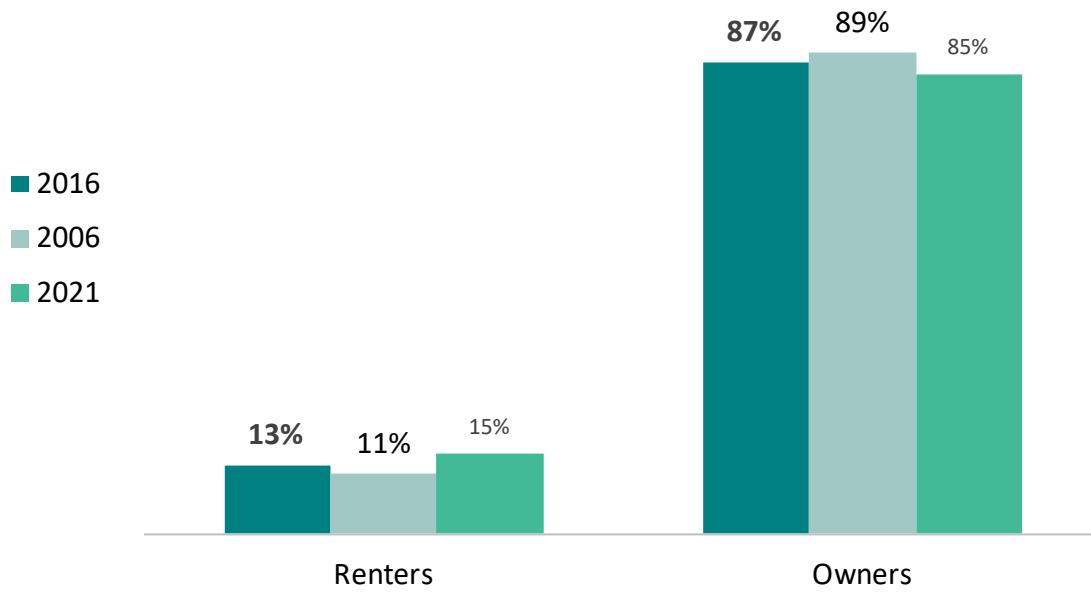
